Meet City Council

The Cleburne City Council consists of four single-member district seats and a mayor.

In the single-member district system, each area elects its own representative. The mayor, however, is elected by all residents eligible to vote.

Cleburne has a council-manager system of government. Under this system, an elected council makes policy and passes ordinances, and the city manager supervises city opera-

tions and implements policies adopted by the council.

Council members serve two-year terms. The council meets at 5 p.m. the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at Cleburne City Hall, 10 N. Robinson St. The city hall building anchoring the east end of downtown, formerly housed a post office. The public is encouraged to attend council meetings. The Council may now order the election cancelled and declare the unopposed candidates elected to office.

The swearing in ceremony is scheduled for the May 9, 2017 regular Council Meeting. ■


