Drones: Toys or Tools?

Are you a drone user? Did you know that when purchasing a drone that there are federal laws and regulations that come along with it? The (Federal Aviation Administration) is the ruling authority of all things flying. If it flies it is considered an aircraft and is subject to FAA rules and regulations. From remote controlled airplanes/helicopters to commercial airliners they all are under the jurisdiction of the FAA.

Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS/Drones) are not just toys but also can be tools used for aerial surveying, photography services, roof inspections, real estate photography or

emergency management/search and rescue missions.

The FAA has a website dedicated to UAS (Drone) use and they also give you information on how to become a licensed UAS (Drone) pilot. If you fly for fun there are no pilot requirements but if you fly for work you must have a Remote Pilot Airman Certificate, be at least 16 years old and pass TSA (Transportation Security Administration) vetting.
