Protect Your Pipes From Freezing Temperatures

With winter approaching, residents and businesses should take steps to keep their water pipes from freezing and possibly bursting. This includes protecting irrigation systems and fire sprinkler systems. Some tips are found below:

- Insulate all outside pipes.
- Insulate pipes in unheated areas (crawl and attic spaces, under cabinets).
- Use insulated covers to protect all outside faucets.
- Know where the main water shut-off valve is located in case a pipe breaks, and it is necessary to turn the water off in a hurry. Check this valve now to make sure it works.
- Keep the lid on the meter box.

- If you must leave your house vacant for a long period, turn off main water shut-off valve and have a plumber prepare the pipes to prevent damage.
- Keep extra water on hand during freezing weather in case a main break or frozen pipe cuts off your water supply.
- If a pipe is frozen, it is safest to call a plumber to handle the problem.
- Commercial buildings with fire sprinklers should leave the heat on overnight and on weekends when sub-freezing temperatures are forecast.
- If there is no water at your location, call the Water Department at 817-645-0919 to determine if your location is impacted by a main break.
