At The Wright Time: Cleburne Code Enforcement Officer Kayla Wright Sworn in as Deputy City Marshal



Congratulations to Cleburne Code Enforcement Officer Kayla Wright on being sworn in as a Deputy City Marshal for the City of Cleburne. Kayla has over four years of law enforcement experience, including one year as a peace officer with the Cleburne Fire Department. She has a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice from Tarleton State University, two Associate degrees from Hill College, and she is a graduate of the Hill College Law Enforcement Academy. Deputy Wright will move to her new office at the police station by January 2nd. A search is currently underway to fill the second code enforcement officer position that

was authorized for FY 2018.

The City Marshal and Deputies serve as peace officers of the City with full police authority in the exercise of assigned duties; enforce federal and state laws, and all rules, regulations and ordinances adopted by the City Council; execute warrants of arrest, subpoenas, summons, and other legal process issued by a judge of the municipal court; and perform other duties as assigned.
