Cleburne police investigate threatening social media post

Cleburne, TX – April 6, 2018 – On Friday, April 6, 2018, at about 8:50 a.m., Cleburne High School officials notified the Cleburne Police Department’s school resource officer of a social media post with a photo of a person holding a rifle, and captions stating “F*** CHS I’m going out with a bang” and “don’t go to school tmrw”. Shortly after this, the department received additional calls in reference to this posting.

Cleburne High School officials initiated a lockdown while additional Cleburne police officers and detectives responded to the school to investigate the incident.

Further investigation revealed that the post originated in Clovis, New Mexico. Cleburne police contacted the Clovis Police Department and confirmed that they have identified the person responsible for this social media post and he is in custody.
