Cleburne residents can drop off their household hazardous waste at the Conquer Your Crud event.

From 9-11 a.m. on Saturday, June 30, at the Cleburne Conference Center, 1501 W. Henderson, residents can properly dispose of a variety of household hazardous waste.

Participants must show a proof of residency on a photo ID showing a Cleburne address or a current city of Cleburne utility bill. For more information call (817) 556-8819.

What's accepted: acids, antifreeze, brake and transmission fluids, batteries, oil filters, degreasers, drain cleaners, fertilizers, unbroken fluorescent light bulbs, paints and stains, thinners, varnish and solvents, herbicides, pesticides, craft, photo, and pool chemicals, and expired personal care products such as hairspray.

What's not accepted: pharmaceuticals, tires, ammunition, explosives, asbestos, medical waste, PCBs, propane or butane cylinders, smoke detectors or radioactive material.


