- **Welcome Garden:** This garden is by the house located in the park. The garden has several perennials and hardy herbs with brick path allowing you to go into the garden.
- **Patio Garden:** The garden is located just off the patio of the house. It offers you the opportunity to continue your stroll from the Welcome to the House Patio.
- **Heritage Rose Garden:** This area is being developed to display roses in Texas during pioneer times.
- **Meditation Garden:** This garden is being developed to serve as a place of reflection.
- **South Entrance Garden:** This is located as Henderson Street entrance. This area has foundation shrubs and annual color.
- **Doctor Buck's Rose Garden:** Dr. Buck did research with roses. The garden reflects the best selection from his research. The garden is located east of the Henderson Street parking area.
- **Wesley's Garden:** This garden is located on the east side of the pond and was designed for constant color serving as a pleasant memory of Wesley.
- **Arbor Rose Garden:** The Arbor is designed to display individuals, corporations, and business that are helping the City of Cleburne create the Botanical Garden. It is also the location of Earth-Kind Roses, both shrub and climbing.
- **Berm Garden:** This is the future location for a plant screen and dry creek.
- **Waterfall and Creek:** The walk approaching this area offers many opportunities to enjoy the sound of water while viewing the planting areas containing low water and low maintenance plants.
- **The pond** has several garden area located around it's perimeters. The plants range from ornamental grasses, pond plants, evergreen shrubs, hummingbird, butterfly plants and many native plants. Several benches along the path offer you a closer view.
