

## **Cleburne Fire Department Frequently Asked Questions:**

**Q. How do I become a Firefighter?**

A. The Fire Department tests once a year. An application and qualifications may be obtained by contacting the Human Resource Department.

**Q. Do I need a permit to burn?**

A. Yes, it is illegal to burn within the city limits. Burn permits are issued thru the Fire Department, if approved by the Fire Marshal of what is to be burned.

**Q. Does the Fire Department issue the burn bans?**

A. No, the burn ban is set by the Johnson County Commissions and they can be located at 817/556-6300. When a burn ban is in effect, no burn permits are issued.

**Q. Where do I get a report on a fire?**

A. The Fire Marshal makes the report and for a \$3.00 fee you may obtain a copy. The Fire Department will be glad to provide you a copy, please contact them at 817/645-0964.

**Q. Does the Fire Department check or refill Fire Extinguishers?**

A. The Fire Department is not licensed to service extinguishers, please contact any State Licensed Fire Extinguisher Company. You may check the yellow pages for information.

**Q. Does the Fire Department fill swimming pools?**

A. No, we recommend you use your own garden hose.

**Q. Does the Fire Department unlock vehicles?**

A. Only on the following conditions:  
Child locked inside  
Person has a valid emergency medical reason
