

## **Parks & Recreation Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q. What areas in the park do you reserve?**

A. The areas available to reserve are the Heritage Pavilion (by the train), the Kimbro-Heritage Pavilion (by the playground), the Gazebo (white shelter south of Splash Station), Carver Park Pavilion & Bryon Stewart Park Pavilion.

**Q. How do you make a reservation?**

A. To make a reservation simply call 817-645-0949 and ask to make a reservation. You must know the date, time to start and time to end to make a reservation.

**Q. How much does it cost to make a reservation at the park?**

A. There is no charge to reserve pavilion or Gazebo, but you do need to make a reservation at 817-645-0949.

**Q. Do the pavilions and Gazebo have electricity or running water?**

A. All of the facilities have an electrical outlet. Only the Heritage Pavilion has access to water.

**Q. Can I take my own grill to the park to use?**

A. Currently we are under a burn ban in Johnson County. When the burn ban is lifted you may grill at the parks.

**Q. If I make a reservation at a facility, can I have a bounce house there?**

A. Yes, you may have a bounce house at the park. To insure everyone's safety, make sure all extension cords are properly in use and out of foot traffic.

**Q. Can you fish in the Buffalo Creek at Hulen Park?**

A. Yes, you can fish at Hulen Park, but you are still required to have a valid fishing license.

**Q. I walk around the path at Hulen Park early in the morning. What if I notice some lights out?**

A. If you notice any lights out at the park areas or anything else that needs to be brought to our attention, please contact the Parks & Recreation office at 817-645-0949.

**Q. Is there overnight camping allowed at Lake Pat Cleburne?**

A. There is no overnight camping allowed at Lake Pat Cleburne. At Buddy Stewart Park overnight camping is allowed only with a self-contained sanitary facility.
