Community to Honor Alex Wilson Night on Tuesday at The Depot

Cleburne, Texas – With a smile big as sunshine Alex Wilson has been a community fixture for years in Cleburne.

Born with cerebral palsy, Wilson, now 24, became affectionately known throughout the community several years ago by commuting around town on his three-wheel bicycle, designed specifically to meet his needs with balance and coordination.

But someone apparently stole Wilson's red bike — which is valued at more than \$3,000 — while it was locked around his mailbox in front of his apartment building the night of May 29.

Friends set up a GoFundMe page where people could donate toward purchasing Wilson a new bike, while others raised money selling lemonade, donated proceeds of their business sales or simply dropped money off at H-E-B Grocery store where he has worked since 2014. More than \$4,000 was raised in one week.

The Cleburne Railroaders will host Alex Wilson Night at The Depot on Tuesday, June 13th. A dollar from each ticket sold will go to a charity of Alex's choice, HEB will have a special presentation for Alex, and Mayor Scott Cain will make him Honorary Mayor for the day.

Wilson will throw out the first pitch prior to the actual game time at 7:06 p.m. signaling the start between the Cleburne Railroaders vs. Salina Stockade.
