Test time: The time allowed for answering questions is 2 hours and 30 minutes.

Compensation: Base Salary \$70,532.80

Eligibility Requirements: This promotional examination shall be held in accordance with the Civil Service Rules and Regulations and shall be open to all Engineers in the Fire Services Division who have served a continuous period of at least (2) two years in the next lower position immediately below that of Lieutenant.

Effective January 1, 2018, to be eligible to promote, the following is added to the minimum eligibility requirements for fire department promotions.

Lieutenant – have successfully obtained 40 college credit hours by the promotional date.

Eligible Candidates: Registration of all eligible candidates desiring to take the examination must be made with the Director of Civil Service, 10 North Robinson, Cleburne, TX no later than 5:00 p.m., Friday, March 2, 2018.

Passing Grade and Seniority Points: Seniority points will be added to each grade, one (1) point for each year of service, up to a maximum of ten (10) points. A total score of at least 70 must be reached regardless of seniority. Seniority points will be added to the final test score.


