

Getting started


With Libby, you can browse, borrow, and enjoy eBooks and audiobooks from your library.

- A library card



- Engineered from the ground up with user feedback in mind.




What makes Libby great?

- Search 'Libby' in Google Play, the Apple App Store, or the Windows App Store.




- Easier than ever to get started.

Libby does more

- Set **Preferences** for browsing.
- Manage **Download Settings** for titles.
 - By default, all titles are downloaded for offline use on wi-fi.
 - You can also choose to:
 - Manually download larger titles.
 - Download titles over cellular.
 - Make Kindle your preferred way to read (*available in the U.S. only*).
- Automatically save library cards.
 - Save multiple library cards.
 - Sync your shelf across libraries.



Libby does even more




- **Tags**
 - Tag titles you love, hate, or want to read.
 - Tag titles into custom lists, too.
- **Activity**
 - Track reading history.
 - **Your timeline** shows all titles borrowed, returned, and placed on hold.
- **Also available as...**
 - Easily link to the other format.
- **Reversed jackets**
 - Cover images flip to the right in search results when you borrow or place a hold.


