The City’s Sign Ordinance, as regulated by the Cleburne Marshal’s Office, determines where and how signs are used within the city limits. Its purpose is to reduce visual clutter and maintain a clean and vibrant community. Make sure you know the sign rules and regulations to avoid citations.

- **Prior to installation, commercial and portable signs must have a valid permit from the city building official. Portable signs displayed on commercial properties may only be displayed for 15 days.**
- **Signs advertising any business can only be displayed on the property where the principal business is *located and operated*.**
- **Residential properties may not display signs for commercial advertising *including any home-based business*.**
- **Political signs must be removed 10 days following the election.**
- **Signs may not be placed on public property, right-of-ways, utility poles, or private property without the consent of the owner.**
- **Signs not authorized in the sign code are subject to notice and removal.**
- ***Bandit Signs* are illegal and are removed without notice.**
